## Membership application process:

Membership is at the discretion of the FPCA committee. Please give your application form and the membership fee to any management committee member or leave with the bar staff Or email back. Membership cards are prepared by the membership secretary and they can be picked up any evening from the bar or by arrangement. Membership is for the year from 1 April to 31 March regardless of the date of joining.

### The Florence Park Community Association membership:

- FULL MEMBERS may vote at the FPCA AGM and are charged the local room hire rates.
- JUNIOR MEMBERS are charged the local room hire rates. They may not vote at the FPCA AGM but are given the special right to elect up to 2 advisers to attend trustee meetings as observers.
- ASSOCIATE MEMBERS will be invited to elect two representatives to vote on their behalf at the FPCA AGM and are charged the associate room hire rates.

### Florence Park Social Club membership:

- FULL AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERS may vote at social club AGM and participate in social club events.
- JUNIOR MEMBERS of the FPCA may not join the social club.

## The FPCA charitable objects

The objects of the Association are to:

- (a) promote the benefit of the inhabitants of Florence Park Estate and the neighbourhood together defined by the area bounded by the Oxford Road, Between Towns Road and Church Cowley Road (including Eleanor Close), Henley Avenue, and the Boundary Brook. (hereinafter called "the area of benefit") without distinction of sex, sexual orientation, race or of political, religious or other opinions, by associating together the said inhabitants and the local authorities, voluntary and other organisations in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation and leisure-time occupation with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said inhabitants;
- (b) establish, or secure the establishment of, a Community Centre (hereinafter called "the Centre") and to maintain and manage the same (whether alone or in co-operation with any local authority or other person or body) in furtherance of these objects.
- (c) promote such other charitable purposes as may from time to time be determined.

The Association shall be non-partisan in politics and non-sectarian in religion.
